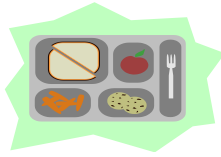

We have been informed that there will be an increase in schools meals supplied by Sodexo to £2.15 per day. This will take effect from September 2010.

Results – Year 6, Year 2 and Reception

Well done to year 6 – their SAT's results reflect a great deal of hard work – the children met their targets which were set for them last November and in some cases have exceeded them!

In Year 2 – all children have achieved a Level 2, the expected level for 7 year old children, in Maths, Reading, Writing and Speaking & Listening.

And – last but by no means least – **ALL our Foundation Stage (Reception)** children have made marked progress in all areas of the Profile, the vast majority scoring at least as high, or exceeding the national expectation of 5 year olds (point 6 on a 9 point scale).
